The Hospital is open:

- **Monday to Friday 8am to 4pm** for all your health concerns. Don't hesitate to present to the hospital, or ring us on 47464000 during these hours and ask to speak to a nurse.
- **Out of hours (4pm to 8am) and weekends**, there is always a nurse on call for emergency presentations.

For any concerns ring us on **47464000** or in an emergency ring **000**

The hospital has access to a doctor 24/7 in Cloncurry, via Telehealth to Mount Isa or on video with TEMSU.

Our nursing staff are able to assess and treat you for a range of health issues such as

- **Feeling unwell**
- **Injuries**
- **Plaster application and removal**
- **Most XRays**
- **Pathology**
- **Eye injuries**
- **Suturing**
- **Wound Care**
- **Immunisations**
- **Emergency care**

For emergency medication:

In day hours: The nurses can contact the Doctor in Cloncurry, the doctor then sends the script to Julia Creek Pharmacy, where it can be picked up.

In an out of hours emergency: The nurse can contact a Doctor via Telehealth and dispense from the hospital.

Physiotherapy and visiting services remain unchanged
