- Young Citizen of the Year must be under the age of 30 on 26th January 2023
- Citizen of the Year must be older than 30 on 26th January 2023
- Nominee must be an Australia Citizen whose permanent place of residence is within McKinlay Shire
- Previous Citizens of the Year winners cannot be re-nominated for the same award
- Elected members of McKinlay Shire Council are ineligible
- Contributions made by nominee have either been completed on a voluntary basis or exceed the normal requirements of the person's paid work.
